- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 545.066(c), Transportation Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (c) An offense under this section is a misdemeanor
- 8 punishable by a fine of not less than \$500 [\$200] or more than
- 9 \$1,250 [\$1,000], except that the offense is:
- 10 (1) a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not less than
- 11 \$1,000 or more than \$2,000 if the person is convicted of a second or
- 12 <u>subsequent offense under this section committed within five years</u>
- 13 of the date on which the most recent preceding offense was
- 14 committed;
- 15 (2) a Class A misdemeanor if the person causes serious
- 16 bodily injury to another; or
- (3) $\left[\frac{(2)}{2}\right]$ a state jail felony if the person has been
- 18 previously convicted under Subdivision (2) [(1)].
- 19 SECTION 2. (a) The change in law made by this Act applies
- 20 only to an offense committed on or after September 1, 2013.
- 21 (b) An offense committed before September 1, 2013, is
