11	insurer if the adjuster is a roofing contractor or otherwise
12	provides roofing services or roofing products for compensation, or
13	is a controlling person in a roofing-related business.
14	(b) The commissioner shall adopt rules necessary to
15	implement and enforce this section.
16	SECTION 2. Subchapter D, Chapter 4102, Insurance Code, is
17	amended by adding Section 4102.163 to read as follows:
18	Sec. 4102.163. CERTAIN ROOFING-RELATED BUSINESS
19	PROHIBITED. (a) A license holder who is a roofing contractor or
20	otherwise provides roofing services or roofing products for
21	compensation, or is a controlling person in a roofing-related
22	<pre>business, may not:</pre>
23	(1) act on behalf of an insured in negotiating for or
24	effecting the settlement of a claim for loss related to roofing

2	(2) on behalf of any other public insurance adjuster,
3	investigate, settle, or adjust or advise or assist an insured with a
4	claim for loss related to roofing damage.
5	(b) The commissioner shall adopt rules necessary to
6	implement and enforce this section.
7	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
