A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

	AN ACT

- 2 relating to an exemption from registration and regulation
- 3 requirements for steam cookers.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 755.001, Health and Safety Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Subdivision (23-a) to read as follows:
- 7 (23-a) "Steam cooker" means a steam heating boiler
- 8 that is:
- 9 (A) designed to steam cook food;
- 10 (B) operated at a pressure not exceeding five
- 11 pounds per square inch; and
- 12 (C) equipped with a safety appliance operated at
- 13 <u>a pressure not exceeding five pounds per square inch.</u>
- 14 SECTION 2. Section 755.022(a), Health and Safety Code, is
- 15 amended to read as follows:
- 16 (a) This chapter does not apply to:
- 17 (1) boilers owned or operated by the federal
- 18 government;
- 19 (2) pressure vessels or process steam generators,
- 20 other than steam collection or liberation drums of process steam
- 21 generators;
- 22 (3) manually fired miniature boilers that:
- 23 (A) are constructed or maintained for
- 24 locomotives, boats, tractors, or stationary engines only as a hobby

- 1 for exhibition, recreation, education, or historical purposes and
- 2 not for commercial use;
- 3 (B) have an inside diameter of 12 inches or less
- 4 or a grate area of two square feet or less; and
- 5 (C) are equipped with a safety valve of adequate
- 6 size, a water level indicator, and a pressure gauge; [or]
- 7 (4) boilers that are designed for operation only at
- 8 atmospheric pressure and that are equipped with two independent
- 9 means to prevent the buildup of pressure; or
- 10 <u>(5)</u> steam cookers.
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 12 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 13 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 14 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 15 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
