1-19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-20 SECTION 1. Section 53.002(f), Government Code, is amended
1-21 to read as follows:

1-22 (f) The judges of the 12th, 106th, 229th, 258th, 278th,
1-23 381st, and 411th district courts may each appoint a bailiff. At the
1-24 discretion of the judge, a bailiff may serve the court in each
1-25 county of the district.

1-26 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
