AN ACT

2 relating to standing for certain individuals to file a suit 3 affecting the parent-child relationship.

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 102.006(c), Family Code, is amended to 6 read as follows:
- 7 (c) The limitations on filing suit imposed by this section
- 8 do not apply to a person related to the child within the third
- 9 degree by consanguinity as determined under Subchapter B, Chapter
- 10 573, Government Code, who otherwise has standing under this chapter
- 11 to file suit [an adult sibling of the child, a grandparent of the
- 12 child, an aunt who is a sister of a parent of the child, or an uncle
- 13 who is a brother of a parent of the child] if the person:
- 14 <u>(1)</u> [adult sibling, grandparent, aunt, or uncle] files
- 15 an original suit or a suit for modification requesting managing
- 16 conservatorship or adoption of the child not later than the 30th
- 17 [90th] day after the date the parent-child relationship between the
- 18 child and the parent is terminated in a suit filed by the Department
- 19 of Family and Protective Services requesting the termination of the
- 20 parent-child relationship; and
- 21 (2) demonstrates that the person's failure to become
- 22 <u>involved</u> in the suit filed by the Department of Family and
- 23 Protective Services was not due to the person's indifference or
- 24 lack of diligence.

- 1 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 2 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 3 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 4 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 5 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
