A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

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- 2 relating to reimbursement of certain providers of durable medical
- 3 equipment and supplies under the Medicaid program.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 32.0314, Human Resources Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 32.0314. REIMBURSEMENT FOR DURABLE MEDICAL EQUIPMENT
- 8 AND SUPPLIES. The executive commissioner of the Health and Human
- 9 Services Commission shall adopt rules requiring that:
- 10 (1) a provider of durable medical equipment and
- 11 supplies under the medical assistance program whose principal
- 12 office is not located in this state be reimbursed at a rate equal to
- 13 85 percent of the rate established for a provider whose principal
- 14 office is located in this state; and
- 15 (2) [the electronic submission of] any claim for
- 16 reimbursement for durable medical equipment and supplies under the
- 17 medical assistance program be electronically submitted.
- 18 SECTION 2. If before implementing any provision of this Act
- 19 a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a
- 20 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,
- 21 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or
- 22 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the
- 23 waiver or authorization is granted.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

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- 1 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 4 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
