- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter G, Chapter 264, Family Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 264.614 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 264.614. INTERNET APPLICATION FOR CASE TRACKING AND
- 9 INFORMATION MANAGEMENT SYSTEM. (a) Subject to the availability of
- 10 money as described by Subsection (c), the department shall develop
- 11 an Internet application that allows a court-appointed volunteer
- 12 advocate representing a child in the managing conservatorship of
- 13 the department to access the child's case file through the
- 14 department's automated case tracking and information management
- 15 system and to add the volunteer advocate's findings and reports to
- 16 the child's case file.
- 17 <u>(b) The court-appointed volunteer advocate shall maintain</u>
- 18 the confidentiality required by this chapter and department rule
- 19 for the information accessed by the advocate through the system
- 20 <u>described by Subsection (a).</u>
- 21 (c) The department may not use money other than money
- 22 received as a gift, grant, or donation to pay for the costs of
- 23 developing and maintaining the Internet application required by
- 24 Subsection (a). The department may solicit and accept gifts,

- 1 grants, and donations of any kind and from any source for purposes
- 2 of this section.
- 3 (d) The executive commissioner of the Health and Human
- 4 Services Commission shall adopt rules necessary to implement this
- 5 <u>section</u>.
- 6 SECTION 2. (a) As soon as practicable after the effective
- 7 date of this Act, the Department of Family and Protective Services
- 8 shall solicit money and develop the Internet application as
- 9 required by Section 264.614, Family Code, as added by this Act.
- 10 (b) As soon as practicable after the effective date of this
- 11 Act, the executive commissioner of the Health and Human Services
- 12 Commission shall adopt rules necessary to implement Section
- 13 264.614, Family Code, as added by this Act.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
