- 10 that subsection, the person was younger than 12 years of age [a
- 11 student in the sixth grade or a lower grade level].
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 37.126(c), Education Code, is amended to
- 13 read as follows:
- 14 (c) It is an exception to the application of Subsection
- 15 (a)(1) that, at the time the person engaged in conduct prohibited
- 16 under that subdivision, the person was younger than 12 years of age
- 17 [a student in the sixth grade or a lower grade level].
- SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 19 an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. An
- 20 offense committed before the effective date of this Act is covered
- 21 by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and the former
- 22 law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of this
- 23 section, an offense was committed before the effective date of this
- 24 Act if any element of the offense was committed before that date.
