## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the operation of certain swimming pools by certain
- 3 populous municipalities.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 315, Local Government Code, is amended
- 6 by adding Section 315.007 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 315.007. OPERATION OF CERTAIN MUNICIPAL SWIMMING POOLS
- 8 REQUIRED. (a) In this section, "municipal swimming pool" means a
- 9 public swimming pool and any attached property or infrastructure
- 10 required to operate the pool that is owned by a municipality.
- 11 (b) This section applies only to a municipality with a
- 12 population of 750,000 or more.
- 13 (c) A municipality must open and operate a municipal
- 14 swimming pool closed for more than one year and less than three
- 15 years if the municipality receives a petition requesting the
- 16 opening of the pool that is filed with the municipal clerk and
- 17 signed by 50 or more qualified voters of the municipality who reside
- 18 within five miles of the pool.
- 19 <u>(d) If the petition is filed before February 1, the</u>
- 20 municipality shall open and operate the municipal swimming pool not
- 21 later than the 180th day after the date the petition is filed. If
- 22 the petition is filed on or after February 1, the municipality may
- 23 open the pool for the summer, if practicable, and shall open the
- 24 pool for the summer of the next calendar year.

- 1 (e) A municipality must maintain and operate a municipal
- 2 swimming pool under this section in the same manner and with the
- 3 same level of service as other comparable municipal swimming pools
- 4 in the municipality.
- 5 (f) This section does not apply to a municipal swimming pool
- 6 that the municipality cannot open due to the existence of a serious
- 7 <u>health and safety issue that through reasonable actions cannot be</u>
- 8 remedied.
- 9 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 10 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 11 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 12 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 13 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
