

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the creation of the Montgomery County Municipal Utility
3 District No. 132; providing authority to impose a tax and issue
4 bonds; granting a limited power of eminent domain.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Subtitle F, Title 6, Special District Local Laws
7 Code, is amended by adding Chapter 8414 to read as follows:

8 CHAPTER 8414. MONTGOMERY COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT

9 NO. 132

10 SUBCHAPTER A. GENERAL PROVISIONS

11 Sec. 8414.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:

12 (1) "Board" means the district's board of directors.

13 (2) "Commission" means the Texas Commission on
14 Environmental Quality.

15 (3) "Director" means a board member.

16 (4) "District" means the Montgomery County Municipal
17 Utility District No. 132.

18 Sec. 8414.002. NATURE OF DISTRICT. The district is a
19 municipal utility district created under Section 59, Article XVI,
20 Texas Constitution.

21 Sec. 8414.003. CONFIRMATION AND DIRECTORS' ELECTION
22 REQUIRED. The temporary directors shall hold an election to
23 confirm the creation of the district and to elect five permanent
24 directors as provided by Section 49.102, Water Code.

1 Sec. 8414.004. CONSENT OF MUNICIPALITY REQUIRED. The
2 temporary directors may not hold an election under Section 8414.003
3 until each municipality in whose corporate limits or
4 extraterritorial jurisdiction the district is located has
5 consented by ordinance or resolution to the creation of the
6 district and to the inclusion of land in the district.

7 Sec. 8414.005. FINDINGS OF PUBLIC PURPOSE AND BENEFIT. (a)
8 The district is created to serve a public purpose and benefit.

9 (b) The district is created to accomplish the purposes of:

10 (1) a municipal utility district as provided by
11 general law and Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution; and

12 (2) Section 52, Article III, Texas Constitution, that
13 relate to the construction, acquisition, improvement, operation,
14 or maintenance of macadamized, graveled, or paved roads, or
15 improvements, including storm drainage, in aid of those roads.

16 Sec. 8414.006. INITIAL DISTRICT TERRITORY. (a) The
17 district is initially composed of the territory described by
18 Section 2 of the Act enacting this chapter.

19 (b) The boundaries and field notes contained in Section 2 of
20 the Act enacting this chapter form a closure. A mistake made in the
21 field notes or in copying the field notes in the legislative process
22 does not affect the district's:

23 (1) organization, existence, or validity;

24 (2) right to issue any type of bond for the purposes
25 for which the district is created or to pay the principal of and
26 interest on a bond;

27 (3) right to impose a tax; or

1 (4) legality or operation.

2 Sec. 8414.007. ELIGIBILITY FOR INCLUSION IN TAX INCREMENT
3 REINVESTMENT ZONE. (a) The district is eligible to be included in
4 a tax increment reinvestment zone created under Chapter 311, Tax
5 Code.

6 (b) If the City of Conroe has created or creates a tax
7 increment reinvestment zone described by Subsection (a) that
8 includes all or part of the territory of the district, the City of
9 Conroe and the board of directors of the zone or a developer of
10 property within the tax increment reinvestment zone that receives
11 or will receive money from the tax increment fund, by contract with
12 the district, may grant money to the district from the tax increment
13 fund to be used for a permissible purpose of the district,
14 including:

15 (1) the right to pledge the money as security for a
16 bond or other obligation issued by the district; and

17 (2) any permissible purpose of a corporation under
18 Section 380.002(b), Local Government Code.

19 SUBCHAPTER B. BOARD OF DIRECTORS

20 Sec. 8414.051. GOVERNING BODY; TERMS. (a) The district is
21 governed by a board of five elected directors.

22 (b) Except as provided by Section 8414.052, directors serve
23 staggered four-year terms.

24 Sec. 8414.052. TEMPORARY DIRECTORS. (a) The temporary
25 board consists of:

26 (1) Bill Odle;

27 (2) Brandon Macey;

1 (3) Troy Koterak;

2 (4) Greg Snider; and

3 (5) Abby McMahon.

4 (b) Temporary directors serve until the earlier of:

5 (1) the date permanent directors are elected under
6 Section 8414.003; or

7 (2) the fourth anniversary of the effective date of
8 the Act enacting this chapter.

9 (c) If permanent directors have not been elected under
10 Section 8414.003 and the terms of the temporary directors have
11 expired, successor temporary directors shall be appointed or
12 reappointed as provided by Subsection (d) to serve terms that
13 expire on the earlier of:

14 (1) the date permanent directors are elected under
15 Section 8414.003; or

16 (2) the fourth anniversary of the date of the
17 appointment or reappointment.

18 (d) If Subsection (c) applies, the owner or owners of a
19 majority of the assessed value of the real property in the district
20 may submit a petition to the commission requesting that the
21 commission appoint as successor temporary directors the five
22 persons named in the petition. The commission shall appoint as
23 successor temporary directors the five persons named in the
24 petition.

25 SUBCHAPTER C. POWERS AND DUTIES

26 Sec. 8414.101. GENERAL POWERS AND DUTIES. The district has
27 the powers and duties necessary to accomplish the purposes for

1 which the district is created.

2 Sec. 8414.102. MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT POWERS AND
3 DUTIES. The district has the powers and duties provided by the
4 general law of this state, including Chapters 49 and 54, Water Code,
5 applicable to municipal utility districts created under Section 59,
6 Article XVI, Texas Constitution.

7 Sec. 8414.103. AUTHORITY FOR ROAD PROJECTS. Under Section
8 52, Article III, Texas Constitution, the district may design,
9 acquire, construct, finance, issue bonds for, improve, operate,
10 maintain, and convey to this state, a county, or a municipality for
11 operation and maintenance macadamized, graveled, or paved roads, or
12 improvements, including storm drainage, in aid of those roads.

13 Sec. 8414.104. ROAD STANDARDS AND REQUIREMENTS. (a) A road
14 project must meet all applicable construction standards, zoning and
15 subdivision requirements, and regulations of each municipality in
16 whose corporate limits or extraterritorial jurisdiction the road
17 project is located.

18 (b) If a road project is not located in the corporate limits
19 or extraterritorial jurisdiction of a municipality, the road
20 project must meet all applicable construction standards,
21 subdivision requirements, and regulations of each county in which
22 the road project is located.

23 (c) If the state will maintain and operate the road, the
24 Texas Transportation Commission must approve the plans and
25 specifications of the road project.

26 Sec. 8414.105. COMPLIANCE WITH MUNICIPAL CONSENT ORDINANCE
27 OR RESOLUTION. (a) The district shall comply with all applicable

1 requirements of any ordinance or resolution that is adopted under
2 Section 54.016 or 54.0165, Water Code, and that consents to the
3 creation of the district or to the inclusion of land in the
4 district.

5 (b) In addition to all the rights and remedies provided by
6 other law, if the district violates the terms of an ordinance or
7 resolution described by Subsection (a), the municipality is
8 entitled to injunctive relief or a writ of mandamus issued by a
9 court requiring the district and the district's officials to
10 observe and comply with the terms of the ordinance or resolution.

11 Sec. 8414.106. EFFECT OF ANNEXATION OR INCLUSION WITHIN THE
12 CORPORATE BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF CONROE. Notwithstanding Section
13 54.016(f)(2), Water Code, an allocation agreement between the City
14 of Conroe and the district that provides for the allocation of the
15 taxes or revenues of the district and the city following the date of
16 inclusion of all the district's territory in the corporate limits
17 of the city may provide that the total annual ad valorem taxes
18 collected by the city and the district from taxable property in the
19 district may exceed the city's ad valorem tax on that property.

20 Sec. 8414.107. LIMITATION ON USE OF EMINENT DOMAIN. The
21 district may not exercise the power of eminent domain outside the
22 district without the written consent of the City of Conroe.

23 SUBCHAPTER D. GENERAL FINANCIAL PROVISIONS

24 Sec. 8414.151. ELECTIONS REGARDING TAXES OR BONDS. (a) The
25 district may issue, without an election, bonds and other
26 obligations secured by revenue other than ad valorem taxes.

27 (b) The district must hold an election in the manner

1 provided by Chapters 49 and 54, Water Code, to obtain voter approval
2 before the district may impose an ad valorem tax or issue bonds
3 payable from ad valorem taxes.

4 (c) The district may not issue bonds payable from ad valorem
5 taxes to finance a road project unless the issuance is approved by a
6 vote of a two-thirds majority of the district voters voting at an
7 election held for that purpose.

8 Sec. 8414.152. OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE TAX. (a) If
9 authorized at an election held under Section 8414.151, the district
10 may impose an operation and maintenance tax on taxable property in
11 the district in accordance with Section 49.107, Water Code.

12 (b) The board shall determine the tax rate. The rate may not
13 exceed the rate approved at the election.

14 SUBCHAPTER E. BONDS AND OTHER OBLIGATIONS

15 Sec. 8414.201. AUTHORITY TO ISSUE BONDS AND OTHER
16 OBLIGATIONS. The district may issue bonds or other obligations
17 payable wholly or partly from ad valorem taxes, impact fees,
18 revenue, contract payments, tax increment payments, grants, or
19 other district money, or any combination of those sources, to pay
20 for any authorized district purpose.

21 Sec. 8414.202. TAXES FOR BONDS. At the time the district
22 issues bonds payable wholly or partly from ad valorem taxes, the
23 board shall provide for the annual imposition of a continuing
24 direct ad valorem tax, without limit as to rate or amount, while all
25 or part of the bonds are outstanding as required and in the manner
26 provided by Sections 54.601 and 54.602, Water Code.

27 Sec. 8414.203. BONDS FOR ROAD PROJECTS. At the time of

1 issuance, the total principal amount of bonds or other obligations
2 issued or incurred to finance road projects and payable from ad
3 valorem taxes may not exceed one-fourth of the assessed value of the
4 real property in the district.

5 SECTION 2. Montgomery County Municipal Utility District No.
6 132 initially includes all the territory contained in the following

5 southeasterly corner of this tract, a 1/2" iron rod found marking an
6 east corner of said 57.98 acre tract, and lying in the northwest
7 right-of-way line of FM 3083 bears S 16 ° 58' 57" E - 865.51 feet;

8 Thence the following calls across the said 57.98 acre tract:

9 S 6 ° 52' 19" W- 449.66 feet to a plastic capped 1/2" iron
10 (stamped Taggart, RPLS # 5676) set for corner;

11 S 24° 00'13" E - 3.19 feet to a plastic capped 1/2" iron

13 S 66° 00' 12" W - 120.00 feet to a plastic capped 1/2" (stamped
14 Taggart, RPLS # 5676) set for corner in the west line of said 57.98
15 acre tract from which a 1/2" iron rod found for a point of curvature
16 in the west boundary line of said 57.98 acre tract bears S 23 °
17 59'48" E - 282.79 feet for reference;

18 Thence the following calls along the said westerly boundary line:

19 N 23° 59' 48" W - 129.37 feet to a 1/2" iron rod found for an
20 angle point;

21 N 36° 28' 06" W- 699.32 feet to a 1/2" iron rod found for an angle
22 point;

23 N 14° 51' 50" W- 405.17 feet to a 1/2" iron rod found for an angle
24 point;

25 N 09° 18' 12" E- 278.32 feet to a 1/2" iron rod found for an angle
26 point;

27 N 18° 07' 05" W- 57.77 feet to the PLACE OF BEGINNING and containing

1 23.69 acres of land.

24 SECTION 3. (a) The legal notice of the intention to
25 introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this
26 Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a
27 copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies,

1 officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished
2 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313,
3 Government Code.

4 (b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has
5 submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on
6 Environmental Quality.

7 (c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed
8 its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor, the
9 lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house of
10 representatives within the required time.

11 (d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this
12 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect
13 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled
14 and accomplished.

15 SECTION 4. (a) Section 8414.107, Special District Local
16 Laws Code, as added by Section 1 of this Act, takes effect only if
17 this Act receives a two-thirds vote of all the members elected to
18 each house.

19 (b) If this Act does not receive a two-thirds vote of all the
20 members elected to each house, Subchapter C, Chapter 8414, Special
21 District Local Laws Code, as added by Section 1 of this Act, is
22 amended by adding Section 8414.107 to read as follows:

23 Sec. 8414.107. NO EMINENT DOMAIN POWER. The district may
24 not exercise the power of eminent domain.

25 (c) This section is not intended to be an expression of a
26 legislative interpretation of the requirements of Section 17(c),
27 Article I, Texas Constitution.

1 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
2 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
3 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
4 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
5 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
