- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 351, Tax Code, is amended
- 6 by adding Section 351.1067 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 351.1067. ALLOCATION OF REVENUE: CERTAIN
- 8 MUNICIPALITIES IN COUNTIES THROUGH WHICH ARANSAS RIVER FLOWS. (a)
- 9 This section applies only to a municipality:
- 10 (1) located in a county with a population of less than
- 11 50,000 through which the Aransas River flows and that has a
- 12 municipality with a population of more than 10,000; and
- 13 (2) that as of April 2013:
- 14 (A) had a water supply of not more than two years;
- 15 and

- 16 (B) had as its primary water source a reservoir
- 17 that was at not more than 15 percent capacity.
- 18 (b) Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter and
- 19 except as provided by Subsection (c), a municipality to which this
- 20 section applies may use not more than 50 percent of the revenue
- 21 derived from the municipal hotel occupancy tax to:
- 22 <u>(1) pay for critical water utility infrastructure</u>
- 23 repairs and improvements needed to address a severe drought that
- 24 affects hotel activity in the municipality; and

- 2 a purpose described by Subdivision (1).
- 3 (c) A municipality to which this section applies may not, as
- 4 a result of spending under Subsection (b), reduce the amount of
- 5 municipal hotel occupancy tax revenue that the municipality spends
- 6 annually on advertising and promotion of the municipality to an
- 7 amount that is less than the average amount the municipality spent
- 8 for that purpose each year from 2010 to 2012.
- 9 (d) This section expires September 1, 2025.
- 10 SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 352, Tax Code, is amended
- 11 by adding Section 352.1041 to read as follows:
- 12 Sec. 352.1041. USE OF REVENUE: CERTAIN COUNTIES THROUGH
- 13 WHICH ARANSAS RIVER FLOWS. Notwithstanding any other provision of
- 14 this chapter, a county with a population of less than 50,000 through
- 15 which the Aransas River flows and that has a municipality with a
- 16 population of more than 10,000 and is authorized to impose a tax
- 17 under this chapter may use not more than 20 percent of the revenue
- 18 from a tax imposed under this chapter for projects to repair
- 19 transportation infrastructure damage that is directly attributable
- 20 to hotel activity in the county.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 25 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
