- 5 SECTION 1. Section 58.007(b), Family Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (b) Except as provided by Article 15.27, Code of Criminal
- 8 Procedure, the records and files of a juvenile court, a clerk of
- 9 court, a juvenile probation department, or a prosecuting attorney
- 10 relating to a child who is a party to a proceeding under this title
- 11 may be inspected or copied [are open to inspection] only by:
- 12 (1) the judge, probation officers, and professional
- 13 staff or consultants of the juvenile court;
- 14 (2) a juvenile justice agency as that term is defined
- 15 by Section 58.101;
- 16 (3) an attorney for a party to the proceeding;
- 17 (4) a public or private agency or institution
- 18 providing supervision of the child by arrangement of the juvenile
- 19 court, or having custody of the child under juvenile court order; or
- 20 (5) with leave of the juvenile court, any other
- 21 person, agency, or institution having a legitimate interest in the
- 22 proceeding or in the work of the court.
- 23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

- 1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
