6	Sec. 772.012. STATE TRADE REPRESENTATIVE. (a) The governor
7	shall designate a state trade representative in the governor's

9	(b) To be eligible for designation as the state trade
10	representative, an individual must have:
11	(1) a degree with specialization in international
12	trade or international relations or a related field; or
13	(2) significant work experience in international
14	trade or international relations or a related field.
15	(c) The state trade representative may not be assigned
16	duties other than duties related to the representative's
17	designation under this section.

- 18 <u>(d) The state trade representative shall annually report to</u>

- 2 (2) major investments made in this state as a result of

- 4 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
