## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the issuance of protective orders for certain sexual,
- 3 stalking, and trafficking offenses.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Article 7A.03, Code of Criminal Procedure, as
- 6 amended by Chapters 135 (S.B. 250) and 238 (H.B. 649), Acts of the
- 7 82nd Legislature, Regular Session, 2011, is reenacted and amended
- 8 to read as follows:
- 9 Art. 7A.03. REQUIRED FINDINGS; ISSUANCE OF PROTECTIVE
- 10 ORDER. (a) At the close of a hearing on an application for a
- 11 protective order under this chapter, the court shall find whether
- 12 there are reasonable grounds to believe that the applicant is the
- 13 victim of sexual assault or abuse, [; or] stalking, or trafficking.
- 14 (b) If the court makes a finding described by Subsection (a)
- 15  $[\frac{(a)(1) \text{ or } (2)}{(a)}]$ , the court shall issue a protective order that
- 16 includes a statement of the required findings.
- 17 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act in amending
- 18 Section 7A.03, Code of Criminal Procedure, applies only to a
- 19 protective order issued on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 20 A protective order issued before the effective date of this Act is
- 21 governed by the law in effect on the date the order is issued, and
- 22 the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
