9	SECTION 2. Section 545.4121(b), Transportation Code, is
10	amended to read as follows:
11	(b) It is a defense to prosecution of an offense to which
12	this section applies that the defendant provides to the court
13	evidence satisfactory to the court that the defendant:
14	(1) at the time of the offense:
15	(A) was not arrested or issued a citation for
16	violation of any other offense; and
17	(B) did not possess a child passenger safety seat
18	system in the vehicle; and
19	(2) subsequent to the time of the offense, obtained
20	[possesses] an appropriate child passenger safety seat system for
21	each child required to be secured in a child passenger safety seat
22	system under Section 545.412(a).
23	SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
24	to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.

1 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is 2 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed, 3 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For 4 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the 5 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred 6 before that date.

7 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
