9	dedicated revenue" means revenue that Section 403.095 makes

11	(b) The board shall:
12	(1) develop and implement a process to review

16	(B) the appropriation and accumulation of

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1 Section 403.095; and 2 (4) for each statutory dedication of revenue, consider 3 whether: 4 (A) the fund or account to which the dedicated 5 revenue is deposited continues to serve the purpose for which the 6 dedication was enacted; 7 (B) the fund or account to which the dedicated 8 revenue is deposited has the capacity to satisfy expenditures for the dedicated purpose; 9 10 (C) there is a clear link between the benefit intended to be gained by the dedication and the source of the 11 12 revenue; and 13 (D) there is a substantial justification for the 14 continued maintenance of the fund or account to which the dedicated 15 revenue is deposited. 16 (c) The board shall: 17 (1) consult with the comptroller as necessary to accomplish the objectives of this section; 18 19 (2) request comments from each state agency that might be affected by recommendations proposed to be made under this 20 subsection or measures proposed to be taken under this subsection; 21 22 (3) make recommendations to the governor, the legislature, and the comptroller concerning whether to continue or 23 24 eliminate any dedications of revenue or any fund or account to which dedicated revenue is deposited or held; and 25 26 (4) incorporate into the board's budget 27 recommendations appropriate measures to reduce state government's

- 4 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
