A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to information that may be requested by the Department of
- 3 Public Safety from a person applying for or renewing a concealed
- 4 handgun license.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 231.302, Family Code, is amended by
- 7 amending Subsection (c) and adding Subsection (c-1) to read as
- 8 follows:
- 9 (c) Except as provided by Subsection (c-1), to [To] assist
- 10 in the administration of laws relating to child support enforcement
- 11 under Parts A and D of Title IV of the federal Social Security Act
- 12 (42 U.S.C. Sections 601-617 and 651-669):
- 13 (1) each licensing authority shall request and each
- 14 applicant for a license shall provide the applicant's social
- 15 security number;
- 16 (2) each agency administering a contract that provides
- 17 for a payment of state funds shall request and each individual or
- 18 entity bidding on a state contract shall provide the individual's
- 19 or entity's social security number as required by Section 231.006[τ
- 20 Family Code]; and
- 21 (3) each agency administering a state-funded grant or
- 22 loan program shall request and each applicant for a grant or loan
- 23 shall provide the applicant's social security number as required by
- 24 Section 231.006[$\frac{}{7}$ Family Code].

- 1 (c-1) For purposes of issuing a license to carry a concealed
- 2 handgun under Subchapter H, Chapter 411, Government Code, the
- 3 Department of Public Safety is not required to request, and an
- 4 applicant is not required to provide, the applicant's social
- 5 security number.
- 6 SECTION 2. Section 411.174, Government Code, is amended by
- 7 adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:
- 8 <u>(d) The department may not request or require an applicant</u>
- 9 to provide the applicant's social security number as part of an
- 10 application under this section.
- 11 SECTION 3. Section 411.185, Government Code, is amended by
- 12 adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:
- 13 <u>(e) The department may not request or require a license</u>
- 14 holder to provide the license holder's social security number to
- 15 renew a license under this section.
- SECTION 4. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 17 to an application for the issuance or renewal of a license to carry
- 18 a concealed handgun submitted on or after the effective date of this
- 19 Act. An application submitted before the effective date of this Act
- 20 is governed by the law in effect when the application was submitted,
- 21 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 22 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
