1-17 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to information that may be requested by the Department of  
1-20 Public Safety from a person applying for or renewing a concealed  
1-21 handgun license.

1-22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-23 SECTION 1. Section 231.302, Family Code, is amended by  
1-24 amending Subsection (c) and adding Subsection (c-1) to read as  
1-25 follows:

1-26 (c) Except as provided by Subsection (c-1), to [To] assist  
1-27 in the administration of laws relating to child support enforcement  
1-28 under Parts A and D of Title IV of the federal Social Security Act  
1-29 (42 U.S.C. Sections 601-617 and 651-669):

1-30 (1) each licensing authority shall request and each  
1-31 applicant for a license shall provide the applicant's social  
1-32 security number;

1-33 (2) each agency administering a contract that provides  
1-34 for a payment of state funds shall request and each individual or  
1-35 entity bidding on a state contract shall provide the individual's  
1-36 or entity's social security number as required by Section 231.006[  
1-37 ~~Family Code~~]; and

1-38 (3) each agency administering a state-funded grant or  
1-39 loan program shall request and each applicant for a grant or loan  
1-40 shall provide the applicant's social security number as required by  
1-41 Section 231.006[~~, Family Code~~].

1-42 (c-1) For purposes of issuing a license to carry a concealed  
1-43 handgun under Subchapter H, Chapter 411, Government Code, the  
1-44 Department of Public Safety is not required to request, and an  
1-45 applicant is not required to provide, the applicant's social  
1-46 security number.

1-47 SECTION 2. Section 411.174, Government Code, is amended by  
1-48 adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:

1-49 (d) The department may not request or require an applicant  
1-50 to provide the applicant's social security number as part of an  
1-51 application under this section.

1-52 SECTION 3. Section 411.185, Government Code, is amended by  
1-53 adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:

1-54 (e) The department may not request or require a license  
1-55 holder to provide the license holder's social security number to  
1-56 renew a license under this section.

1-57 SECTION 4. The change in law made by this Act applies only  
1-58 to an application for the issuance or renewal of a license to carry  
1-59 a concealed handgun submitted on or after the effective date of this  
1-60 Act. An application submitted before the effective date of this Act

2-1 is governed by the law in effect when the application was submitted,  
2-2 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.  
2-3 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect January 1, 2014.
