7	district shall equip each district school with three or more
8	electronic alarms designed to be used to alert law enforcement of
9	the need for an emergency response. The alarm must be easy to
10	activate and may be controlled by a button.
11	(b) The board of trustees of each school district shall
12	adopt a policy for placement and use at the district's schools of
13	the alarms described by Subsection (a). The policy must:
14	(1) require that:
15	(A) at least one of the alarms be placed in the
16	school principal's office; and
17	(B) another of the alarms be placed in another
18	location at the school;
19	(2) require that a designated school employee wear a
