## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to validating certain acts of the Lower Nueces River Water
- 3 Supply District transferring real property rights.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. On or before August 1, 1986, in accordance with
- 6 Chapter 844, Acts of the 69th Legislature, Regular Session, 1985,
- 7 the board of directors of the Lower Nueces River Water Supply
- 8 District paid or provided for the payment of all debts and
- 9 liabilities of the district and transferred all district assets to
- 10 the City of Corpus Christi, including all district rights to real
- 11 property. Additionally, the district's enabling legislation,
- 12 Chapter 159, Acts of the 51st Legislature, Regular Session, 1949,
- 13 was repealed, and the Lower Nueces River Water Supply District was
- 14 dissolved in accordance with Chapter 844.
- 15 SECTION 2. (a) The governmental acts and proceedings of
- 16 the Lower Nueces River Water Supply District taken to comply with
- 17 Chapter 844, Acts of the 69th Legislature, Regular Session, 1985,
- 18 relating to the 1986 transfer to the City of Corpus Christi of
- 19 district rights to real property included in the 1986 quitclaim
- 20 deed recordings described by Section 3 of this Act are validated and
- 21 confirmed as of the dates the transfers occurred. The acts and
- 22 proceedings may not be held invalid because they were not performed
- 23 in accordance with Chapter 51, Water Code, or other law.
- (b) The 1986 transfer of rights to real property included in

- 1 the 1986 quitclaim deed recordings described by Section 3 of this
- 2 Act by the Lower Nueces River Water Supply District to the City of
- 3 Corpus Christi may not be held invalid on the ground that the
- 4 transfer, in the absence of this Act, was invalid.
- 5 (c) The City of Corpus Christi is the owner of the rights to
- 6 real property transferred to the city in accordance with Chapter
- 7 844, Acts of the 69th Legislature, Regular Session, 1985, and
- 8 included in the 1986 quitclaim deed recordings described by Section
- 9 3 of this Act.
- 10 (d) This section does not apply to any matter that on the
- 11 effective date of this Act:
- 12 (1) is involved in litigation if the litigation
- 13 ultimately results in the matter being held invalid by a final court
- 14 judgment; or
- 15 (2) has been held invalid by a final court judgment.
- 16 SECTION 3. The property transfers made in 1986 as quitclaim
- 17 deeds in accordance with Section 3, Chapter 844, Acts of the 69th
- 18 Legislature, Regular Session, 1985, transferring property from the
- 19 Lower Nueces River Water Supply District to the City of Corpus
- 20 Christi have been filed as follows:
- 21 (1) in Nueces County on September 26, 2011, as
- 22 Document 2011034981 filed in the property records of Nueces County;
- 23 (2) in Atascosa County on September 30, 2011, as
- 24 recording number 125295 filed in the property records of Atascosa
- 25 County;
- 26 (3) in Jim Wells County on September 27, 2011, as
- 27 recording number 413632 filed in the property records of Jim Wells

- 1 County;
- 2 (4) in Live Oak County on September 27, 2011, as
- 3 recording number 195798 filed in the property records of Live Oak
- 4 County; and
- 5 (5) in San Patricio County on September 27, 2011, as
- 6 recording number 611795 filed in the property records of San
- 7 Patricio County.
- 8 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 9 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 10 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 11 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 12 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
