EXEMPTION FROM ELECTRONIC FILING FEES. An attorney licensed to practice law in this state who is a solo 8 9 practitioner is exempt from a fee imposed for the electronic filing of documents under this subchapter by a district or county clerk, a 10 clerk of a court of appeals, or a vendor contracting to provide 11 12 electronic filing services for the district, county, or court of 13 appeals. SECTION 2. Section 51.808, Government Code, as added by 14 this Act, applies only to a fee imposed for the electronic filing of 15 documents on or after the effective date of this Act. 16 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013. 17
