5	SECTION 1. Chapter 241, Health and Safety Code, is amended
6	by adding Subchapter H to read as follows:
7	SUBCHAPTER H. FREESTANDING EMERGENCY MEDICAL CARE FACILITIES
8	ASSOCIATED WITH LICENSED HOSPITALS
9	Sec. 241.181. APPLICABILITY. This subchapter applies only
10	to a freestanding emergency medical care facility, as that term is
11	defined by Section 254.001, that is exempt from the licensing
12	requirements of Chapter 254 under Section 254.052(7) or (8).
13	Sec. 241.182. ADVERTISING. A facility described by Section
14	241.181 may not advertise or hold itself out as a medical office,
15	facility, or provider other than an emergency room if the facility
16	charges for its services the usual and customary rate charged for
17	the same service by a hospital emergency room in the same region of
18	the state or located in a region of the state with comparable rates
19	for emergency health care services.
20	Sec. 241.183. POSTED NOTICE. Subject to Section 241.006,
21	the department shall adopt rules for a notice to be posted in a
22	conspicuous place in the facility described by Section 241.181 that
23	notifies prospective patients that the facility is an emergency
24	room and charges rates comparable to a hospital emergency room.

- 2 (a) A person who violates this subchapter commits a false,
- 3 misleading, or deceptive act or practice within the meaning of
