## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the regulation of food prepared, stored, distributed,
3	or sold at farms and farmers' markets; limiting the applicability
4	of a fee.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Section 437.001, Health and Safety Code, is
7	amended by adding Subdivisions (3-b) and (6) to read as follows:
8	(3-b) "Farmers' market" means a designated location
9	used primarily for the distribution and sale directly to consumers
10	by farmers or other producers.
11	(6) "Produce" means fresh fruits or vegetables.
12	SECTION 2. Section 437.020, Health and Safety Code, is
13	amended to read as follows:
14	Sec. 437.020. <u>REGULATION OF FOOD</u> [PRODUCE] SAMPLES AT FARMS
15	AND [MUNICIPALLY OWNED] FARMERS' MARKETS. (a) In this section,
16	"food" means an agricultural, apicultural, horticultural,
17	silvicultural, viticultural, or vegetable product for human
18	consumption, in either its natural or processed state, that has
19	been produced or processed or otherwise has had value added to the
20	<pre>product in this state. The term includes:</pre>
21	(1) fish or other aquatic species;
22	(2) livestock, a livestock product, or a livestock
23	by-product;

(3) planting seed;

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1 (4) poultry, a poultry product, or a poultry 2 by-product; 3 (5) wildlife processed for food or by-products; 4 (6) a product made from a product described by this 5 subsection by a farmer or other producer who grew or processed the product; or 6 (7) produce. 7 Except as provided by this section and Sections 8 437.0201, 437.0202, and 437.0203 [Subsection (b)]: 9 (1) this chapter does not regulate the provision of 10 samples of <u>food</u> or the sale of food [produce] to consumers at a <u>farm</u> 11 or [municipally owned] farmers' market; and 12 a rule adopted under state law may not regulate the 13 14 provision of samples of food or the sale of food [produce] to 15 consumers at a farm or [municipally owned] farmers' market. 16 (c) Samples of food [(b) Produce samples] may [only] be 17 prepared and distributed at a farm or [municipally owned] farmers' market if the following sanitary conditions exist: 18 19 [produce samples must be kept in approved, clean, and covered containers; 20 21  $[\frac{(2) \text{ produce}}]$  samples must be distributed in a sanitary manner; 22 23 (2) a person preparing produce samples on-site must: 24 (A) wear  $[\frac{(3)}{(3)}]$  clean, disposable plastic gloves 25 [must be used] when preparing [cutting produce] samples; or 26 (B) observe proper hand washing techniques

immediately before preparing samples;

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               (3) [(4)] produce intended for sampling must be washed
   in potable water to remove any soil or other visible material [so
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   that it is wholesome and safe for consumption];
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               (4) [<del>(5)</del>] potable water must be available for [hand]
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   washing [and sanitizing as approved by the local or state
   enforcement agency];

               (5) except as provided by Section 437.0202(b), [\frac{(6)}{(6)}]

   potentially hazardous food [cut produce], as determined by rule of
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four [two] hours after cutting or preparing; and 11 (6) [<del>(7) utensil and hand washing water must be</del> 12 disposed of in a facility connected to the public sewer system or in 13

the department, must be maintained at or below 41 degrees

Fahrenheit or[, and produce samples must be] disposed of within

- 14 a manner approved by the local or state enforcement agency; and
- 15 [<del>(8)</del>] utensils and cutting surfaces <u>used for cutting</u> samples must be smooth, nonabsorbent, and easily cleaned or 16 17 disposed of [as approved by the local or state enforcement agency].
- SECTION 3. Section 437.0201, Health and Safety Code, is 18 19 amended by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (e) to
- read as follows: 20

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- 21 In this section, "food" has the meaning assigned by Section 437.020 ["farmers' market" means a designated location used
- primarily for the distribution and sale directly to consumers of 23
- 24 food products by farmers or other producers].
- (e) The executive commissioner or a state or local 25
- 26 enforcement agency may not adopt a rule requiring a farmers' market
- to pay a permit fee for conducting a cooking demonstration or 27

- 1 providing samples of food if the demonstration or provision of
- 2 samples is conducted for a bona fide educational purpose.
- 3 SECTION 4. Sections 437.0202(a) and (b), Health and Safety
- 4 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 5 (a) In this section, "food" ["farmers' market"] has the
- 6 meaning assigned by Section 437.020 [437.0201].
- 7 (b) The executive commissioner by rule may adopt
- 8 temperature requirements for food sold at, prepared on-site at, or
- 9 transported to or from a farmers' market under Section 437.020,
- 10 [<del>or</del>] 437.0201, or 437.0203. Food prepared on-site at a farmers'
- 11 market may be sold or distributed at the farmers' market only if the
- 12 food is prepared in compliance with the temperature requirements
- 13 adopted under this section.
- SECTION 5. Chapter 437, Health and Safety Code, is amended
- 15 by adding Section 437.0203 to read as follows:
- 16 Sec. 437.0203. REGULATION OF COOKING DEMONSTRATIONS AT
- 17 FARMERS' MARKETS. (a) In this section, "food" has the meaning
- 18 assigned by Section 437.020.
- 19 (b) Except as provided by this section and Sections 437.020,
- 20 <u>437.0201</u>, and 437.0202:
- 21 (1) this chapter does not regulate cooking
- 22 demonstrations at a farmers' market; and
- 23 (2) a rule adopted under state law may not regulate
- 24 cooking demonstrations at a farmers' market.
- 25 <u>(c) A person may conduct a cooking demonstration at a</u>
- 26 farmers' market only if:
- 27 (1) regardless of whether the demonstrator provides a

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- 1 sample of food to consumers, the farmers' market that hosts the
- 2 demonstration:
- 3 (A) has an establishment operator with a valid
- 4 certification under Subchapter D, Chapter 438, supervising the
- 5 demonstration; and
- 6 (B) complies with Sections 437.020 and 437.0202,
- 7 the requirements of a temporary food establishment under this
- 8 chapter, and rules adopted under this chapter; and
- 9 (2) when the demonstrator provides a sample of food to
- 10 consumers:
- 11 (A) the demonstrator provides a sample only and
- 12 not a full serving; and
- 13 (B) samples of food prepared during a
- 14 demonstration are disposed of not later than four hours after the
- 15 beginning of the demonstration.
- 16 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
