## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the state contribution for the Teacher Retirement 3 System of Texas.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 825.404, Government Code, is amended by 6 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (a-1) to read as 7 follows:

8 (a) During each fiscal year, the state shall contribute to 9 the retirement system an amount equal to at least <u>7.4</u> [six] and not 10 more than 10 percent of the aggregate annual compensation of all 11 members of the retirement system during that fiscal year. The 12 amount of the state contribution made under this section may not be 13 less than the amount contributed by members during that fiscal year 14 in accordance with Section 825.402.

(a-1) Notwithstanding Subsection (a), during the fiscal 15 year beginning September 1, 2013, the state shall contribute to the 16 retirement system an amount equal to 6.9 percent of the aggregate 17 annual compensation of all members of the retirement system during 18 that fiscal year. During the fiscal year beginning September 1, 19 2014, the state shall contribute to the retirement system an amount 20 equal to 7.4 percent of the aggregate annual compensation of all 21 members of the retirement system during that fiscal year. This 22 23 subsection expires September 1, 2015.
