1-19 relating to the authority of a county road department to accept
 1-20 donations.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 252, Transportation Code,
 1-23 is amended by adding Section 252.314 to read as follows:

1-24 Sec. 252.314. DONATIONS. A commissioners court may accept
 1-25 donations of labor, money, or other property to aid in the building
 1-26 or maintaining of roads in the county.

1-27 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-28 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-29 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-30 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-31 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
