(a) The Texas Board of Health and the Texas Department of Health were abolished by Section 8 9 1.26, Chapter 198 (H.B. 2292), Acts of the 78th Legislature, Regular Session, 2003, and the powers and duties of those entities 10 11 under this chapter were transferred to other agencies, which are 12 subject to Chapter 325, Government Code (Texas Sunset Act). Unless the agencies to which those powers and duties are transferred are 13 14 continued in existence as provided by that chapter, this chapter expires September 1, 2015. 15 16 (b) In the review of the Department of State Health Services by the Sunset Advisory Commission, as required by this section and 17 Section 1001.003, the sunset commission shall review the powers and 18 duties exercised by the department under Chapter 108 and determine 19 whether the department, under that chapter, is: 20

consumers with information to make informed health care decisions;

standards for patient information; and

- 14 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 18 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
