6	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
7	SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 33, Education Code, is
8	amended by adding Section 33.0834 to read as follows:
9	Sec. 33.0834. UNIVERSITY INTERSCHOLASTIC LEAGUE: SELECTION
10	OF LOCATIONS FOR CERTAIN STATEWIDE COMPETITIONS. (a) The
11	University Interscholastic League shall select locations for
12	statewide competitions in extracurricular academic or musical
13	activities sponsored or sanctioned by the league in accordance with
14	this section.
15	(b) For each extracurricular academic or musical activity
16	for which the University Interscholastic League sponsors or
17	sanctions a statewide annual competition, the league shall on a
18	biennial basis issue a statewide request for proposals from
19	institutions of higher education and other appropriate entities
20	seeking to host the statewide competition for two consecutive

- 1 statewide competition; and
- 2 (2) require an entity to submit relevant information

- 6 response to a request for proposals, the University Interscholastic

- 9 SECTION 2. Section 33.0834, Education Code, as added by
- 10 this Act, applies only to a statewide competition to be held on or
- 11 after September 1, 2014.
- 12 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
