- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 451, Labor Code, is amended by adding
- 6 Section 451.0025 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 451.0025. WAIVER OF IMMUNITY; PERMISSION FOR FIRST
- 8 RESPONDER TO SUE. (a) In this section, "first responder" has the
- 9 meaning assigned by Section 421.095, Government Code.
- 10 (b) A first responder who alleges a violation of Section
- 11 451.001 by a state or local governmental entity that employs the
- 12 first responder may sue the governmental entity for the relief
- 13 provided by this chapter. Sovereign or governmental immunity from
- 14 suit is waived and abolished to the extent of liability created by
- 15 this chapter.
- 16 (c) To the extent a person has official or individual
- immunity from a claim for damages, this section does not affect that
- 18 <u>immunity</u>.
- 19 SECTION 2. Section 504.002, Labor Code, is amended by
- 20 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (a-1) to read as

- 23 of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the cause of
- 24 action accrued, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 25 purpose.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
