## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to prohibiting the board of trustees of an independent
- 3 school district from disparate treatment based on an organization's
- 4 religious nature in allowing access to school campuses after school
- 5 hours.
- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 11, Education Code, is
- 8 amended by adding Section 11.1651 to read as follows:
- 9 Sec. 11.1651. PROHIBITION OF DISPARATE TREATMENT BASED ON
- 10 RELIGIOUS NATURE OF ORGANIZATION IN ALLOWING ACCESS TO SCHOOL
- 11 CAMPUSES AFTER SCHOOL HOURS. If the board of trustees of an
- 12 independent school district allows noncurricular community
- 13 organizations not organized or operated primarily by students
- 14 access to district school campuses after school hours, the district
- 15 must provide religious organizations the same access to school
- 16 campuses after school hours as is given to other noncurricular
- 17 organizations without discrimination based on any religious nature
- 18 of an organization or on an organization's activities on campus,
- 19 including religious expression.
- 20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
