A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the supervision required for certain persons who
- 3 administer rabies vaccinations.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 826.023, Health and Safety Code, is
- 6 amended by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (f) to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (f), rabies [Rabies]
- 9 vaccine for animals may be administered only by or under the direct
- 10 supervision of a veterinarian.
- 11 (f) A trained staff member of a municipal or county animal
- 12 shelter may administer rabies vaccine to an animal kept or
- 13 impounded at the animal shelter under the general supervision of a
- 14 veterinarian. For the purposes of this subsection, "animal
- 15 shelter" has the meaning assigned by Section 823.001 and "general
- 16 supervision" has the meaning assigned by Section 801.002,
- 17 Occupations Code.
- 18 SECTION 2. Subchapter H, Chapter 801, Occupations Code, is
- 19 amended by adding Section 801.3515 to read as follows:
- 20 <u>Sec. 801.3515. EXCEPTION TO VETERINARIAN-CLIENT-PATIENT</u>
- 21 RELATIONSHIP REQUIREMENT FOR CERTAIN PERSONS WHO ADMINISTER RABIES
- 22 VACCINE. A person who administers rabies vaccine under the general
- 23 supervision of a veterinarian as provided by Section 826.023(f),
- 24 Health and Safety Code, and the veterinarian who provides that

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- 1 supervision are not required to establish a
- 2 veterinarian-client-patient relationship before administering the
- 3 <u>rabies vaccine.</u>
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
