 1-19 AN ACT

1-20 relating to events to educate students about Type 2 diabetes in  
 1-21 certain school districts.

1-22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-23 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 38, Education Code, is  
 1-24 amended by adding Section 38.028 to read as follows:

1-25 Sec. 38.028. TYPE 2 DIABETES PREVENTION AND AWARENESS  
 1-26 PROGRAM. (a) This section applies only to a school district with a  
 1-27 student enrollment of at least 60,000 that is located in a county on  
 1-28 the international border with a population of 800,000 or more.

1-29 (b) A school district to which this section applies shall  
 1-30 hold an event once each school year in which local nonprofit  
 1-31 diabetes prevention organizations visit each school campus to  
 1-32 educate students in the third through 12th grades about Type 2  
 1-33 diabetes prevention and awareness.

1-34 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2013-2014  
 1-35 school year.

1-36 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
 1-37 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
 1-38 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
 1-39 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
 1-40 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
