## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to license examination attempt limits for certain
3	physicians.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 155.056, Occupations Code, is amended by
6	adding Subsections (e) and (f) to read as follows:
7	(e) Notwithstanding Subsection (a), an applicant must pass
8	each part of an examination within five attempts if the applicant:
9	(1) is licensed and in good standing as a physician in
10	another state;
11	(2) has been licensed for at least five years;
12	(3) does not hold a medical license in the other state
13	that has or has ever had any restrictions, disciplinary orders, or
14	<pre>probation;</pre>
15	(4) is specialty board certified by a specialty board
16	that:
17	(A) is a member of the American Board of Medical
18	Specialties; or
19	(B) is approved by the American Osteopathic
20	Association; and
21	(5) will practice for at least three years in a
22	medically underserved area or a health manpower shortage area, as
23	those terms are defined by Section 157.052.
24	(f) The board may by rule establish a process to verify that

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- 1 <u>a person</u>, after meeting the requirements of Subsection (e),
- 2 practices only in an area described by Subsection (e)(5).
- 3 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
