## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the searchable state expenditure database maintained by 3 the comptroller.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 403.024, Government Code, is amended by 6 amending Subsection (c) and adding Subsection (c-1) to read as 7 follows:

8 (c) To the extent possible, the comptroller shall present 9 information in the database established under this section in a 10 manner that is searchable and intuitive to users. The comptroller 11 shall enhance and organize the presentation of the information 12 through the use of graphical representations, such as pie charts, 13 as the comptroller considers appropriate. At a minimum, the 14 database must allow users to:

(1) search and aggregate state funding by any elementof the information;

17 (2) ascertain through a single search the total amount
18 of state funding awarded to a person by a state agency; [and]

19 (3) download information yielded by a search of the20 database; and

21 (4) for a state expenditure in the form of a grant, 22 ascertain the specific purposes for which the grant money was used. 23 (c-1) Subsection (c)(4) does not apply to information 24 relating to a state expenditure in the form of a grant if the
