1 AN ACT 2 relating to the slaughter of certain domestic or exotic fowl 3 infected with or exposed to disease and compensation of owners of fowl infected with or exposed to disease. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 6 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 161.0415, Agriculture Code, is amended to read as follows: 7 Sec. 161.0415. DISPOSAL OF DISEASED OR EXPOSED LIVESTOCK OR 8 9 FOWL. SECTION 2. Sections 161.0415(a) and (b), Agriculture Code, 10 11 are amended to read as follows: 12 (a) The commission by order may require the slaughter of 13 livestock, domestic fowl, or exotic fowl, under the direction of 14 the commission, or the sale of livestock, domestic fowl, or exotic fowl for immediate slaughter at a public slaughtering establishment 15 maintaining federal or state inspection if the livestock, domestic 16 fowl, or exotic fowl is exposed to or infected with a disease other 17 than bluetonque or vesicular stomatitis that: 18 is recognized by the United States Department of 19 (1)20 Agriculture as a foreign animal disease; 21 (2) is the subject of a cooperative eradication 22 program with the United States Department of Agriculture; is named on "List A" of the Office International 23 (3) 24 Des Epizooties; or

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1 (4) is the subject of a state of emergency, as declared
2 by the governor.

The commission by order may require the slaughter and 3 (b) disposal of livestock, domestic fowl, or exotic fowl exposed to or 4 infected with a disease not listed in Subsection (a) if the 5 6 commission determines that action to be necessary for the protection of animal health in this state. The commission shall 7 8 immediately deliver a copy of an order issued under this subsection to the appropriate legislative oversight committees. 9

10 SECTION 3. The heading to Section 161.058, Agriculture 11 Code, is amended to read as follows:

12 Sec. 161.058. COMPENSATION OF LIVESTOCK OR FOWL OWNER.

13 SECTION 4. Sections 161.058(a) and (c), Agriculture Code, 14 are amended to read as follows:

(a) The commission may pay an indemnity to the owner of livestock, domestic fowl, or exotic fowl exposed to or infected with a disease if the commission considers it necessary to eradicate the disease and to dispose of the exposed or diseased livestock, domestic fowl, or exotic fowl. The commission shall provide the owner with information regarding available state or federal indemnity funds.

(c) The commission may spend funds appropriated for the purpose of this section only for direct payment to owners of exposed or infected livestock, domestic fowl, or exotic fowl.

25 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 26 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 27 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
