A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to an exemption from the sales tax for firearms and hunting supplies for a limited period. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter H, Chapter 151, Tax Code, is amended by adding Section 151.358 to read as follows: 6 Sec. 151.358. FIREARMS AND HUNTING SUPPLIES FOR LIMITED 7 PERIOD. (a) In this section, "hunting supplies" means ammunition, 8 archery equipment, hunting blinds and stands, hunting decoys, 9 firearm cleaning supplies, gun cases and gun safes, and hunting 10 11 optics. 12 (b) The sale of a firearm or hunting supplies is exempted from the taxes imposed by this chapter if the sale takes place 13 14 during a period beginning at 12:01 a.m. on March 2 and ending at 12 midnight on the same day. 15 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act does not 16 affect tax liability accruing before the effective date of this 17 Act. That liability continues in effect as if this Act had not been 18 enacted, and the former law is continued in effect for the 19 collection of taxes due and for civil and criminal enforcement of 20 21 the liability for those taxes. 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 24
