1-19 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
 1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to the designation of a segment of U.S. Highway 75 in  
 1-22 Collin County as the Prisoner of War Memorial Highway.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 225, Transportation Code,  
 1-25 is amended by adding Section 225.091 to read as follows:

1-26 Sec. 225.091. PRISONER OF WAR MEMORIAL HIGHWAY. (a) The  
 1-27 portion of U.S. Highway 75 in Collin County between its  
 1-28 intersection with the President George Bush Highway and its  
 1-29 intersection with U.S. Highway 380 is designated as the Prisoner of  
 1-30 War Memorial Highway. The designation is in addition to any other  
 1-31 designation.

1-32 (b) Subject to Section 225.021(c), the department shall:

1-33 (1) design and construct markers indicating the  
 1-34 designation as the Prisoner of War Memorial Highway and any other  
 1-35 appropriate information; and

1-36 (2) erect a marker at each end of the highway and at  
 1-37 appropriate intermediate sites along the highway.

1-38 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
