2 relating to the authority of a county to contract with a private

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 351.102, Local Government Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 351.102. ADDITIONAL AUTHORITY TO CONTRACT. The
- 8 commissioners court of a county may contract with a private vendor
- 9 to provide for the financing, design, construction, leasing,
- 10 operation, purchase, maintenance, or management of a jail,
- 11 detention center, work camp, or related facility. The
- 12 commissioners court may not award a contract under this section
- 13 unless the commissioners court requests proposals by public notice
- 14 and not less than 30 days from such notice receives a proposal that
- 15 meets or exceeds the requirements specified in the request for
- 16 proposals. Before the commissioners court of a county enters into a
- 17 contract under this section, the commissioners court of the county
- 18 must receive the written approval of the sheriff of the county,
- 19 which written approval shall not be unreasonably withheld, or if
- 20 the county has a population of 2.8 million or more:
- 21 (1) consult with the sheriff regarding the feasibility
- 22 of ensuring [ensure] that all services provided under the contract
- 23 are required to meet or exceed standards set by the Commission on
- 24 Jail Standards; or

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- 1 (2) receive the written approval of the sheriff of the
- 2 county, which written approval shall not be unreasonably withheld.
- 3 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 4 to a contract entered into on or after the effective date of this
- 5 Act. A contract entered into before the effective date of this Act
- 6 is governed by the law in effect when the contract was entered into,
- 7 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 8 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 9 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 10 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 11 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 12 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
