 1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to fees of office for directors of groundwater
 1-22 conservation districts.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Section 36.060(a), Water Code, is amended to
 1-25 read as follows:

1-26 (a) A director is entitled to receive fees of office of not
 1-27 more than \$250 [~~\$150~~] a day for each day the director actually
 1-28 spends performing the duties of a director. The fees of office may
 1-29 not exceed \$9,000 a year.

1-30 SECTION 2. This Act applies only to a fee paid to a director
 1-31 of a groundwater conservation district for duties performed on or
 1-32 after the effective date of this Act. A fee paid for duties
 1-33 performed before that date is governed by the law in effect on the
 1-34 date the duties are performed, and that law is continued in effect
 1-35 for that purpose.

1-36 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
