- 8 Sec. 39.0521. REVOCATION OF ACCREDITATION FOR VIOLATING THE
- 9 TEXAS CONSTITUTION. (a) If the attorney general determines that a
- 10 school district knowingly violated a provision of the Texas
- 11 Constitution, the commissioner shall revoke the accreditation of
- 12 the district and order the closure of the district.
- 13 <u>(b) If the commissioner revokes the accreditation of a</u>
