1-20 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-21 AN ACT

1-22 relating to authorizing an optional county fee on vehicle
 1-23 registration in certain counties.

1-24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-25 SECTION 1. Sections 502.402(a) and (e), Transportation
 1-26 Code, are amended to read as follows:

1-27 (a) This section applies only to:

1-28 (1) a county:

1-29 (A) [~~(1)~~] that borders the United Mexican
 1-30 States;

1-31 (B) [~~(2)~~] that has a population of more than
 1-32 300,000; and

1-33 (C) [~~(3)~~] in which the largest municipality has a
 1-34 population of less than 300,000; and

1-35 (2) a county that has a population of more than 1.5
 1-36 million that is coterminous with a regional mobility authority.

1-37 (e) The additional fee shall be collected for a vehicle when
 1-38 other fees imposed under this chapter are collected. The fee
 1-39 revenue collected shall be sent to the regional mobility authority
 1-40 of the county to fund long-term transportation projects in the
 1-41 county that are consistent with the purposes specified by Section
 1-42 7-a, Article VIII, Texas Constitution.

1-43 SECTION 2. Section 502.402, Transportation Code, as amended
 1-44 by this Act, applies only to the fee for a registration period
 1-45 beginning on or after the effective date of this Act. A fee for a
 1-46 registration period beginning before the effective date of this Act
 1-47 is governed by the law in effect when the registration period began,
 1-48 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.

1-49 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
