- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 1201.109, Insurance Code,
- 6 is amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 1201.109. NOTICE OF RATE INCREASE FOR MAJOR MEDICAL
- 8 EXPENSE INSURANCE POLICY.
- 9 SECTION 2. Section 1201.109, Insurance Code, is amended by
- 10 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (f) to read as
- 11 follows:
- 12 (a) Not less than 60 days before the date on which a premium
- 13 rate increase takes effect on an individual accident and health
- 14 insurance policy that provides major medical expense coverage and
- 15 that is delivered or issued for delivery in this state by an
- 16 insurer, the insurer shall:
- 17 (1) give written notice to the insured of the
- 18 effective date of the increase; and
- 19 (2) provide the insured a table that clearly lists:
- 20 (A) the actual dollar amount of the premium on
- 21 the date of the notice;
- 22 (B) the actual dollar amount of the premium after
- 23 the premium rate increase; and
- (C) the percentage change between the amounts

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- 1 described by Paragraphs (A) and (B).
- 2 (f) For purposes of this section, "major medical expense
- 3 <u>coverage" means an individual major medical expense insurance</u>
- 4 policy to which this chapter applies under Section 1201.003 that
- 5 constitutes creditable coverage under Section 1205.004.
- 6 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- $7\,$ a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 8 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 9 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 10 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
