H.B. No. 1591

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to designation of certain vehicles of the Texas Division
- 3 of Emergency Management as authorized emergency vehicles.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 541.201(1), Transportation Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (1) "Authorized emergency vehicle" means:
- 8 (A) a fire department or police vehicle;
- 9 (B) a public or private ambulance operated by a
- 10 person who has been issued a license by the [Texas] Department of
- 11 State Health Services;
- 12 (C) a municipal department or public service
- 13 corporation emergency vehicle that has been designated or
- 14 authorized by the governing body of a municipality;
- 15 (D) a vehicle that has been designated by the
- 16 department under Section 546.0065;
- 17 <u>(E)</u> a private vehicle of a volunteer firefighter
- 18 or a certified emergency medical services employee or volunteer
- 19 when responding to a fire alarm or medical emergency;
- 20 $\underline{\text{(F)}}$ [$\frac{\text{(E)}}{\text{)}}$] an industrial emergency response
- 21 vehicle, including an industrial ambulance, when responding to an
- 22 emergency, but only if the vehicle is operated in compliance with
- 23 criteria in effect September 1, 1989, and established by the
- 24 predecessor of the Texas Industrial Emergency Services Board of the

- 1 State Firemen's and Fire Marshals' Association of Texas;
- $\underline{\text{(G)}}$ [(F)] a vehicle of a blood bank or tissue
- 3 bank, accredited or approved under the laws of this state or the
- 4 United States, when making emergency deliveries of blood, drugs,
- 5 medicines, or organs; or
- (H) $[\frac{(G)}{(G)}]$ a vehicle used for law enforcement
- 7 purposes that is owned or leased by a federal governmental entity.
- 8 SECTION 2. Subchapter A, Chapter 546, Transportation Code,
- 9 is amended by adding Section 546.0065 to read as follows:
- 10 Sec. 546.0065. AUTHORIZED EMERGENCY VEHICLES OF THE TEXAS
- 11 DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT. The department shall designate
- 12 <u>vehicles of the Texas Division of Emergency Management that may be</u>
- 13 operated as authorized emergency vehicles.
- 14 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 18 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
