- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 25.0453, Government Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subsection (g) to read as follows:
- 7 (g) The judge of a statutory probate court may, unless a
- 8 party objects, provide that a proceeding be recorded by a good
- 9 quality electronic recording device instead of by a court reporter.
- 10 A stenographic record of an electronically recorded proceeding is
- 11 not required except on order of the judge. If a recording device is
- 12 used, the court reporter is not required to be present to certify
- 13 the record. The judge may designate one or more persons to act as
- 14 the court recorder and shall assign to a court recorder the duties
- 15 and responsibilities necessary to act in that capacity.
- 16 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 17 to a proceeding commenced on or after the effective date of this
- 18 Act. A proceeding commenced before the effective date of this Act is
- 19 covered by the law in effect immediately before the effective date
- 20 of this Act, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 21 purpose.
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
