- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 22.021(e) and (f), Penal Code, are
- 6 amended to read as follows:

- 7 (e) An offense under this section is a felony of the first 8 degree, except as provided by Subsection (f).
- 9 (f) (1) An offense under this section is a felony of the first
- 10 degree, punishable by imprisonment in the Texas Department of
- 11 Criminal Justice for life or for any term of not more than 99 years
- 12 or less than [The minimum term of imprisonment for an offense under
- 13 this section is increased to] 25 years, if at the time of the
- 14 offense the defendant is younger than 17 years of age and:
- (A) $\left[\frac{1}{1}\right]$ the victim of the offense is younger
- 16 than six years of age [at the time the offense is committed]; or
- 17 $\underline{\text{(B)}}$ [$\frac{\text{(2)}}{\text{)}}$] the victim of the offense is six years
- 18 of age or older but younger than 14 years of age [at the time the
- 19 offense is committed] and the actor commits the offense in a manner
- 20 described by Subsection (a)(2)(A).
- 21 (2) An offense under this section is a felony of the
- 22 first degree, punishable by imprisonment in the Texas Department of
- 23 Criminal Justice for life without parole, if at the time of the
- 24 offense the defendant is 17 years of age or older and:

- 1 (A) the victim of the offense is younger than six
- 2 years of age;
- 3 (B) the victim of the offense is six years of age
- 4 or older but younger than 14 years of age and suffered bodily injury
- 5 as a result of the offense; or
- 6 (C) the victim of the offense is 14 years of age
- 7 or older but younger than 17 years of age and suffered serious
- 8 bodily injury as a result of the offense.
- 9 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 10 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 11 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 12 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,
- 13 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 14 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
- 15 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred
- 16 before that date.
- 17 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
