- 2 relating to timing and frequency with which a public utility may
- 3 file for a rate change application.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. 13.187, Water Code, is amended as follows:
- 6 (p) Except to implement a rate adjustment provision
- 7 approved by the regulatory authority by rule or ordinance, as
- 8 applicable, or to adjust the rates of a newly acquired utility
- 9 system, a utility or two or more utilities under common control and
- 10 ownership may not file a statement of intent to increase its rates
- 11 <u>for the same customer</u> more than once in a 12-month period, unless
- 12 the regulatory authority determines that a financial hardship
- 13 exists. If the regulatory authority requires the utility to
- 14 deliver a corrected statement of intent, the utility is not
- 15 considered to be in violation of the 12-month filing requirement.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
