5	SECTION 1. Chapter 39, Subchapter B of the Human Resources
6	Code is amended by adding Section 39.46:
7	Section 39.46. Reporting Requirement. (a) The department,
8	as the agency responsible for administering the TWHP, must annually
9	submit a report to the Legislature assessing the true capacity and
10	service capabilities of the direct providers on its list. The
11	report must contain, at a minimum, the following criteria:
12	(i) The exact number of patients each direct provider has

- 14 (ii) A formulaic analysis of how the provider and/or the department assessed the number of patients in Section 39.46(a)(i); 15
- (iii) The number of patients each direct provider served in 16 the previous fiscal year under the TWHP; 17
- (iv) The number of physicians for each direct provider that 18 perform services under the TWHP; 19
- 20 (v) A description of the services that each direct provider 21 has the capability to provide under the TWHP; and
- 22 (vi) A description of the services that each direct provider
- does not have the capability to provide under the TWHP. 23
- 24 (b) The department, as the agency responsible for

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- 1 administering the TWHP, must submit the report under Section
- 2 39.46(a) to the Legislature as soon as practically possible, but no
- 3 later than January 31st of each legislative session.
- 4 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
