- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Chapter 2172, Government Code, is amended by
- 5 adding Section 2172.007 to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 2172.007. SHIPPING COORDINATION SERVICES. (a) The
- 7 comptroller shall contract with a vendor to provide shipping
- 8 coordination services to all state agencies. The vendor shall
- 9 arrange the shipment of goods, parcels, and freight using the
- 10 shipping company that provides the lowest cost or best value to the
- 11 agency for the shipment.
- 12 (b) A state agency shall arrange all shipments of goods,
- 13 parcels, and freight using the vendor under this section.
- 14 (c) The vendor under this section shall maintain a record of
- 15 each shipment arranged for a state agency, including the cost of the
- 16 shipment, the type of goods, parcels, or freight shipped, and the
- 17 weight of the goods, parcels, or freight shipped.
- 18 <u>(d) In contracting for services under this section, the</u>
- 19 comptroller shall provide contracting opportunities for, and
- 20 increase contract awards to, vendors that employ veterans or other
- 21 persons with disabilities whose products and services are available
- 22 <u>under Chapter 122, Human Resources Code.</u>
- 23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

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- 1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
