1-14 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
 1-15 AN ACT

1-16 relating to the authority of the mayors of certain municipalities  
 1-17 to call a special meeting.

1-18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-19 SECTION 1. Section 22.038(b), Local Government Code, is  
 1-20 amended to read as follows:

1-21 (b) The mayor may call a special meeting on the mayor's own  
 1-22 motion and shall call a special meeting ~~or~~ on the application of  
 1-23 three aldermen. Each member of the governing body, the secretary,  
 1-24 and the municipal attorney must be notified of the special meeting.  
 1-25 The notice may be given personally or left at the person's usual  
 1-26 place of residence.

1-27 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
 1-28 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
 1-29 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
 1-30 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
 1-31 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
