## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
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- 2 relating to suicide reporting by hospitals and emergency medical
- 3 care facilities.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 108.002, Health and Safety Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Subdivisions (1-a) and (8-b) and amending
- 7 Subdivisions (8-a) and (12) to read as follows:
- 8 (1-a) "Attempted suicide" means a self-inflicted,
- 9 destructive act committed with explicit or inferred intent to die.
- 10 (8-a) "Emergency medical care facility" means a
- 11 freestanding emergency medical care facility licensed under
- 12 <u>Chapter 254.</u>
- 13 (8-b) "Executive commissioner" means the executive
- 14 commissioner of the Health and Human Services Commission.
- 15 (12) "Hospital" means a public, for-profit, or
- 16 nonprofit institution licensed or owned by this state that is a
- 17 general or special hospital, private mental hospital, chronic
- 18 disease hospital, or other type of hospital. The term includes a
- 19 <u>hospital's emergency room.</u>
- 20 SECTION 2. Chapter 108, Health and Safety Code, is amended
- 21 by adding Section 108.0101 to read as follows:
- Sec. 108.0101. COLLECTION AND DISSEMINATION OF ATTEMPTED
- 23 <u>SUICIDE INFORMATION</u>. (a) The department shall collect information
- 24 regarding an attempted suicide by a patient examined by a hospital

- 1 or emergency medical care facility.
- 2 (b) Notwithstanding Sections 108.006(b)(3) and 108.009(f),
- 3 a hospital or emergency medical care facility shall submit a report
- 4 regarding a patient's attempted suicide not later than the 30th day
- 5 after the date the hospital or emergency medical care facility
- 6 examines the patient.
- 7 (c) Notwithstanding Sections 108.006(b)(3) and 108.009(f),
- 8 a hospital or emergency medical care facility shall report to the
- 9 department any month when the hospital or facility had zero
- 10 attempted suicides during the month. The report must be in the form
- 11 prescribed by the department and submitted not later than the 15th
- 12 day of the following month.
- 13 (d) A person who submits a report of an attempted suicide
- 14 under this section or examines or treats an attempted suicide
- 15 reported under this section may not be held civilly or criminally
- 16 <u>liable for complying with the requirements of this section.</u>
- (e) Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter,
- 18 reports, records, and information obtained or developed by the
- 19 department under this section are confidential and are not subject
- 20 to disclosure under Chapter 552, Government Code, are not subject
- 21 to subpoena, and may not otherwise be released or made public except
- 22 as provided by this section.
- 23 (f) Each quarter, at the request of an agency or
- 24 organization with recognized expertise in suicide prevention, the
- 25 department shall release information reported under this section,
- 26 in the form of a statistical report, to the agency or organization.
- 27 The statistical report must be released in a manner that prevents

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- 1 the identification of any person. The department may charge the
- 2 agency or organization a reasonable fee to offset the costs of
- 3 releasing the statistical report. The agency or organization may
- 4 use information contained in a statistical report received under
- 5 this subsection only for suicide prevention purposes.
- 6 (g) Information collected under this section may be
- 7 released for statistical purposes if released in a manner that
- 8 maintains patient confidentiality as provided by Section 108.013.
- 9 (h) The executive commissioner may adopt rules necessary to
- 10 implement this section.
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
