8	Sec. 205.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:
9	(1) "Firearm" has the meaning assigned by Section
10	46.01, Penal Code.
11	(2) "Package" means a box or container holding a good
12	or product for sale or sold to an end user.
13	Sec. 205.002. APPLICABILITY. This chapter applies only to
14	a firearm or ammunition for a firearm manufactured on or after
15	September 1, 2014.
16	Sec. 205.003. MANUFACTURER NOTICE: NEW FIREARM. A
17	manufacturer of a firearm may not sell in this state, or ship into
18	this state for sale or resale or in connection with a sale, a new
19	firearm unless the firearm's package includes, in bold font equal
20	to or greater in size than the surrounding text, a notice disclosing
21	the maximum distance a projectile travels when fired from the
